



Alcohol & Drugs Policy

Being under the influence of alcohol or drugs can seriously impair an individual's judgment and reactions, leading to an increased risk of accidents and injuries occurring. Alcohol and drug abuse can also have a detrimental effect on work performance and behaviour.

1. No member of EPMIS should be in possession of alcohol or illegal drugs whilst on the shed premises.
2. No member of EPMIS should try to attend a shed session when unfit to do so whilst under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs.
3. No member of EPMIS should supply others with alcohol or illegal drugs whilst attending a shed session.
4. Members who take prescription drugs should ensure they are aware of any side effects which could affect work performance or endanger the health and safety of themselves or others as a consequence.

The EPMIS Committee reserve the right to refuse admission to a shed session for anyone not adhering to this policy.
